

EVERY EVENT OF THE MONTH article has a beautiful flyer in the *Stampin' Success* section on the demonstrator website. Print it out, hand it out at your event, and each customer will have supplies and instructions for the project right in front of them while they create.

Looking for a sure-fire way to boost your sales and grow your customer base? Try a productbased class! It's easy—there are only four steps:

- Determine what products you want to feature in your class and the projects the attendees will make. For example, you might feature the Daisy Delight Stamp Set and the Daisy Punch.
- 2. Set your fee and advertise your class. The fee should include the purchase of the product(s) being featured (in this case, the Daisy Delight Bundle, item 145361). You can determine if the class fee will include the cost of other products that will be used, including paper, accessories, and adhesives. Encourage your customers to invite their friends!
- Collect the fees and order the products. You might want to create product packets for each attendee. Use 6" x 8" Cellophane Bags

to create project packets that contain precut paper and embellishments.

4. Hold the class. Have displays with the projects for the attendees to look at. Consider playing background music and having treats for guests to snack on while they create!

Not only do product-based classes guarantee greater sales, they also offer opportunities for selling additional products:

- Point out products that you've supplied and suggest they purchase their own so they can make more projects. (Remember: they now own the stamp set and punch!)
- Upsell adhesive or tools like Paper Snips, Bone Folders, or a Stampin' Trimmer.
- · Talk about bundles and how convenient they are!

If a one-size-fits-all method doesn't work for your customers, consider using a tiered approach; this allows you to be sensitive to your customers' budgets by offering different pricing depending on the tier. A tiered structure might look something like this:

- Tier 1: Ribbon and Designer Series Paper
- Tier 2: Daisy Delight Bundle
- Tier 3: Bundle, Ribbon, and Designer Series Paper
- Tier 4: Choose your own products; spend at least \$25

However you choose to go about it, a product-based class equals success for you, your customers, and your business! §

Thank You Note Card (3-1/2" x 5")

Daisy Delight (Adorable marguerite/Gänseblümchengruß) Stamp Set; Vellum and Whisper White Cardstock; Calypso Coral, Daffodil Delight, Old Olive, Pear Pizzazz, and Rich Razzleberry Classic Stampin' Pads; VersaMark Pad; Gold Stampin' Emboss Powder: Stampin' Dimensionals

Create the gingham pattern by stamping the Diagonal Stripe Background Stamp, turning your paper 90 degrees, and stamping again.
