- Four Season Floral Stamp Set
- Jar of Flowers Bundle
- Whisper White Cardstock
- Flowers for Every Season Cards & Envelopes
- Bumblebee Classic Stampin' Pad
- Just Jade Classic Stampin' Pad
- Block D
- Cinnamon Cider 1/4" (6.4 mm) Ribbon
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Mini Glue Dots
- Stampin' SEAL

ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED

- Paper Trimmer

HAPPY BIRTHDAY CARD



INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fold card base.
2. Cut Whisper White Cardstock to 3" x 4" (7.6 x 10.2 cm) to fit inside the pre-printed rectangle.
3. Stamp "Happy birthday" in Just Jade ink.
4. Stamp jar image in Just Jade ink on a 2" (5.1 cm) wide scrap of Whisper White Cardstock.
5. Stamp the water image in Just Jade ink. Tip: Stamp off before stamping inside the jar. Punch out the jar using the Jar Punch.
6. Wrap the Cinnamon Cider 1/4" (6.4 mm) Ribbon around the jar and tie a knot. Tip: Apply a bit of Stampin' SEAL to the back of the jar to keep the ribbon in place.
7. Stamp the flower image in Bumblebee ink on Whisper White Cardstock. Optional: Stamp flowers on the coordinating envelope.
8. Adhere the stamped Whisper White Cardstock to the card base using Stampin' SEAL.
9. Adhere the jar to the card using Stampin' Dimensionals.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Fold card base.
2. Stamp roses image on the card base in Bumblebee ink. Optional: Stamp flowers on the coordinating envelope.
3. Stamp "Thank you" on 1" x 1-1/2" (2.5 x 3.8 cm) scrap of Whisper White Cardstock.
4. Cut a 6" (15 cm) length of Cinnamon Cider 1/4" (6.4 mm) Ribbon; fold in half.
5. Apply a small strip of Stampin' SEAL to the card base where it will be hidden under the ribbon; attach the ribbon as shown.
6. Adhere Stampin' Dimensionals (cut in half) to the four corners of the label piece; adhere the thank you label over the ribbon.
